## Foreword

Nepalese Civil Airworthiness Requirements, known hereafter as NCAR January 2009 edition have been issued by Director General pursuant to Rule 82 of Civil Aviation Regulation 2002 (2058 B.S.). These Requirements complement and amplify the Civil Aviation Regulation 2002 (2058 B.S.).

The Requirements have been developed in line with latest amendments to Annexes 1, 6,7,8 and 16 to convention in order to fulfill the state's obligation towards implementation of International Civil Aviation Organization(ICAO) standard and recommended practices of ICAO.

This issue of NCAR supersedes the applicable Requirements of previous issues. These Requirements are applicable to all Nepalese registered aircraft, and, if specifically stated, to foreign aircraft operating in Nepal. These Requirements are also applicable to AOC holders, maintenance organizations, supplier organizations and owners and operators of aircrafts apart from concerned persons or agency mentioned therein.

This issue of NCAR comes into force with effective from 30<sup>th</sup> January 2009.
